User-friendly and highly secure, School Web Lockers is a hosted paperless homework system, which makes managing computers easy for schools by eliminating the need for both user and system administration. The cost for the service is \$1 per user per year with a one time initial set up fee of \$700 (discounts available for large districts)

FEATURES

MY HOME FOLDER

Students and teachers use their personal home folder to store files that they can access from any Internet connected computer. These files can be work in progress or completed documents users want to maintain. Users can create as many sub-folders as needed to organize files and the home folder stays with the user semester after semester and year after year.



MY CLASSES

For teachers, posting assignments takes only seconds. The process requires that the teacher simply click on the browse button to locate a file, then upload the file to have it sent to all students in a particular class. All popular file formats are supported. Students can retrieve any assignments that their teachers have posted by clicking on the assignments link.

ASSIGNMENTS

Teachers can access any finished assignments students have submitted. Each document lists the file owner, the student who turned in the assignment, as well as the date and time it was turned in. In this directory, files do not over-write one another, so you don't have to worry about having the students come up with unique file names.

Students can turn in assignments to their teachers. Students will only see the files he/she uploaded to the teacher so you don't have to worry about students "sharing" work.

GRADING ASSIGNMENTS

Teachers can grade assignments through the system as well. If the teacher has made a change to a file the student submitted, the teacher can send it back to the student with the changes. Individual discussion can take place between the student and teacher through these threads.



E-PORTFOLIO

This is where the student can showcase his/her best work. Sub folders can be created within the E-Portfolio to maintain organization and students and teachers have the ability to comment on individual files or the portfolio as a whole. The portfolio remains with the student throughout his/her career.

MESSAGE BOARDS

The message boards are designed to enhance school-wide or even district-wide communication for all students, teachers and administrators. Anytime a comment is posted, the name of the person posting it is attached as well as the date and time.

CALENDAR

Teachers have the ability to post items on either their own personal calendar, or on the students' calendars. When adding a calendar event, the teacher will either choose to post on "my calendar only," or on student calendars for the classes they teach. Students have the ability to post items on their own calendars only. District or school administrators can post on everyone's calendars.



BLOGS/CLASS DISCUSSION

Only a teacher can start a blog on the system, and only those students enrolled in that teacher's classes can comment on it. The blog is "read-only" for all others, so parents don't need a login name and password to access it. We can also set up parent accounts if full access is required.

The class discussion is private and can only be viewed by the users associated with the class. This is to encourage additional discussion outside of the classroom.
